

Did You Know?

If a babies' father does not sign the birth certificate and the father is a registered status Indian, the baby may only be registered under section 6(2) which is a lesser form of status. Or worse, they may not be entitled to status!



This is because the Registrar of the Department of Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) assumes the “unstated” father is a non-Indian. This negatively affects our children’s entitlement to registration.
